# Whiskey, Wiretaps, and the Northwest's Rumrunning King



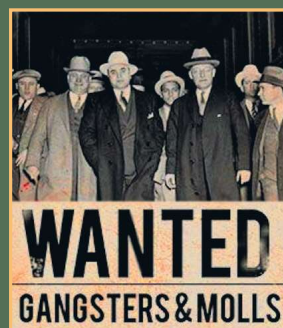
